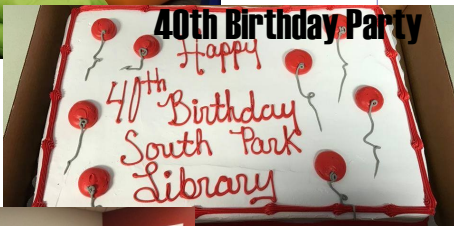

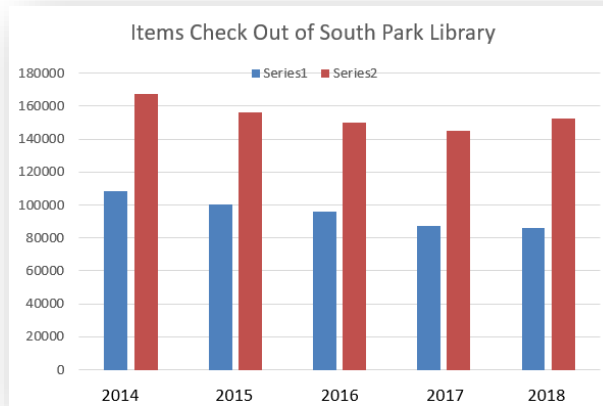


Greetings From the Director

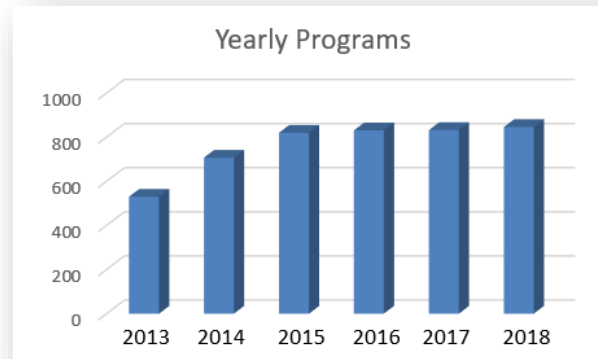

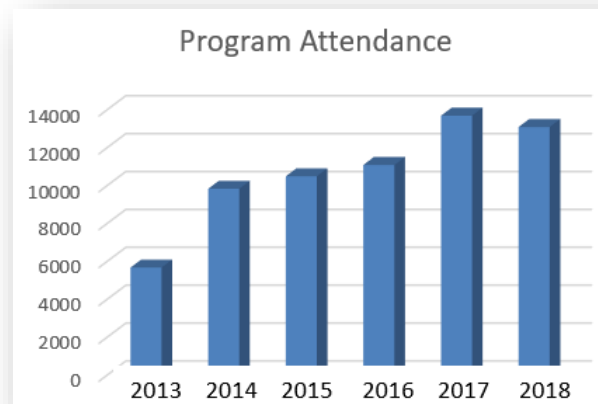
