Frequently Asked Questions: South Park Library Computer Classes



How do I sign up for a Computer Class?

Select one of the registration links on the Library's Computer Class page https://southparklibrary.org/computerclasses.html or the Library's Adult Program page at https://southparklibrary.org/adultprograms.html. We will need your name, phone number, and e-mail address.

Are the Classes Free?

Yes, all computer classes are free to the public.

Where do the computer classes take place?

Our computer classes will take place at the computer station behind the glass in the back of the library, unless otherwise noted.

When do computer classes take place?

Computer classes take place on certain Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Classes begin at 5:30pm. For specific dates and times for each computer class, please ask a librarian, give the library a call at 412-833-5585, or consult a computer class schedule flyer.

Do I need to bring anything to class?

You will need to have an active library card to log on to the computers and a willingness to learn. Although not a requirement, patrons are welcome to bring their laptops, tablets, etc. with them.

How many people can sign up for one class?

The maximum amount of people we accept in a single class is **six (6) people**.

If anyone signs up after the **six (6) person limit is reached**, they will be placed on a waiting list.
