National Aviary

Friday April 13 at 10:00am

Pittsburgh's National Aviary is the Nation's premier bird zoo. The National Aviary's collection features birds representing every continent except Antarctica. Many of these species are showcased in free-flight mixed species exhibits, to allow the birds to demonstrate natural behaviors. We will get a personalized tour of the aviary and will hang out until 12:30 when new baby sloth Vivien is fed. We will leave South Park Library at 10:00am for an 11:00am tour and then head to Burgatory on the North Shore for lunch at 1:00 and then back to SPL by 3:00. The cost is \$50 per person.

'Burgh Bits and Bites Food Tour of the Strip District

The Strip District Market tour features a behind-the-counter look at a variety of eateries in Pittsburgh's historic market district. This tour links local history with the eating establishments peppered along Penn Avenue with taste samples from around the world including Italian pastries, Mediterranean and Polish specialties, European meats and cinnamon bread. We will leave SPL at 9:00am for a 10:00am tour. The tours last 2-2 ½ hours. We will return to SPL by 1:30. The cost is \$55 per person.

In the Grant Street area, you'll see fountains in Mellon Green, Mellon Square, and in the courtyard of the Allegheny County Courthouse. After exploring Market Square, the fountain at PPG Place, our guided tour ends at Point State Park. We will then lunch at 3 Rivers Restaurant and Lounge in the Wyndham Grand. We will leave SPL at 9:00 for a 10:00am tour that lasts 2 hours. Lunch will be at 12:15 and we will return to SPL by 2:00. The cost is \$50.00 per person.
